

- 1. Navigation issues
- Just **put a new menu** into Firefox Menubar with:
- -- where is the webmail
- -- where is the project management system
- -- where is the company wiki
- -- where is ... whatever you need

1. Ubiquity

You don't have to explain to your Boss what Ubiquity is.
