


Phase 3 Planning: Where are we now?

World class infrastructure


online organizing platform and expert team

- Use that to tee up 2016 goals + H1 initiatives


Plus:

- Pick a core element / focus for MLN (e.g., convening)






Strawman Program Design w. Initatives Leadership




Strawman Program Design w. Initatives Leadership






Mozilla Advocacy Program Design
