Mozilla QA is the Mozilla Quality Assurance


- We test new Firefox Releases to maintain the great quality of Firefox, Fennec and Thunderbird

- ▶ We organize QA Events (Testdays/Bugdays) Meetups and join Conferences to get more interested people involved and to help them to get started in QA!

Bugs


Triaging bugs in Bugzilla, reproducing topcrashers, reporting issues, etc.

Bug Triage

Conf rm, specify Steps To Reproduce (STR), regression ranges. Respond to qawanted, regressionwindow-wanted

Testing

Help testing new features, join test days and bug days, test releases, create manual test cases, create automated test cases, encourage community testers.

Test Tools

Help maintain and develop MozMill, unit test infrastructure, QA Companion extension, analysis tools, performance tools, build tools
