

### Types and Locations Notifications


# Notification Center in the Utility Tray All app related notifications live in the notification center.



#### **Full Screen**


Very important notification, it interrupts all activity. Only for incoming call.

#### **Alert**


Interrupts and requires an action before proceeding.



#### **Badges**

Numerical update on icons in carousel.
Only for **app** related notifications.


#### **Passive**

Appear and go away automatically.



Reserved for **app** related notifications, they are present until phone is unlocked.

### Core or Trusted Applications **Alert Notifications**




#### **Details**

- lcon
  - Ilcon signifying the application from which the Notification belongs to.
- If a message, the title represents the name of the sender.
- Body
  If a message, the body gives a preview of the content of the message. If an email, the body gives the subject of the email.
- Action
  Actions can be comprised of one or two buttons.

If two buttons, the positive action or what leads to viewing the message or acting on it is on the right.

The negative action that dismisses the notification without taking action is on the left.

### Untrusted Applications **Alert Notifications**







- lcon
  Ilcon signifying the application from which the
  Notification belongs to.
- Title
  For an untrusted application, the title must contain the name of the application.
- Body
  If a message, the body gives the name of the sender, and a preview of the message.
- 4 Otherwise it contains simple content,
- Action
  Actions can be comprised of one or two buttons.

If two buttons, the positive action or what leads to viewing the message or acting on it is on the right.

The negative action that dismisses the notification without taking action is on the left.



### Notification Length **Alert Notifications**






#### **Text Length**

- Short Message Notifications
  If the text message does not exceed three lines, the entire message should be viewable in the notification window, and the action can be to reply directly.
- Long Message Notification

  If the text message exceeds three lines, it should be cut and the reply button should be a View button leading to viewing the full message in the respective application.

### Volume and Mute Control Feedback Alert Notifications





#### **Details**

Volume Feedback

When the hardware volume buttons are pressed, and the user is not on the lock screen, a notification appears instantly indicating the volume level the user is adjusting to.


It also provides an indication how to mute the phone via hardware volume (if no physical silence switch is present).

Unmute Feedback

When the user mutes the phone, this passive notification appears instantly giving visual feedback and an indication of how to unmute the phone.
