
Customizable dock behavior






Description

For V1, the fixed communication bar is removed



- Apps can be moved between the grid and the dock. App icons in the customizable dock will be of the same size as apps in the application grid.
 - The dock could hold up nine apps. We propose including a horizontally gesture on the dock to scroll horizontally.

Search from Home. (e.g. widget in home page)

Tap search widget to open search field.


Home with expanded search widget

In the main home screen a search widget is present together with the customizlable dock.


Exact search behavior is TBD. Proposal is to initiate web search.

Search Models and everything.me integration




Homescreen

Application gridApplications come in from the right side, whilst the background stays





First page of application grid in focus.



Flick (or drag) on dock to move between next/previous set of apps




Dock navigationThe dock animates to the second set...





Edit mode: as previously agreed




Application gridLong press starts edit mode.

In edit mode, application deletable apps get a badge icon on top. All app icons are pulsating to indicate edit mode.




The user can drag icons in and out of the customizable dock, delete deletable apps and re-arrange application order.

Note: Applications in dock are not shortcuts.


Delete an app: as previously agreed

Appliction grid: edit modeConfirm deleting the app




Appliction grid: edit mode

Applications re-arrange filling out the empty app slot. User remains in edit mode until pressing hardware home key.


Set wallpaper: as previously agreed

From the action list, the user can pick wallpaper from the camera photos or from default wallpapers (which both has the same interaction flow)





Photo picker grid

User can pick any photo in the photo grid



The Zoom in/out keys allows the user to pick a specific area of a photo.


The user can move around the frame to pick what part to be the wallpaper.

Home screen Task switcher



Task switcher

The Zoom in/out keys allows the user to pick a specific area of a photo.


Description

Task switching is accessed through long press on the hardware home key. By default the last active application is shown to the very left, followed by up to 19 other applications (20 in total in order to keep a smooth performance) The task switcher holds all active applications and lets the user scroll horizontally between them. By tapping an active application the user access it and it's last state.

Whenever accessing the task switcher, the dock will always be found in the bottom giving quick access to the users favorite apps.

Note: Current implementation does not have the dock. Previous designs incorporated the search bar which is now on homescreen/landing page.




Homescreen Four applications in dock
