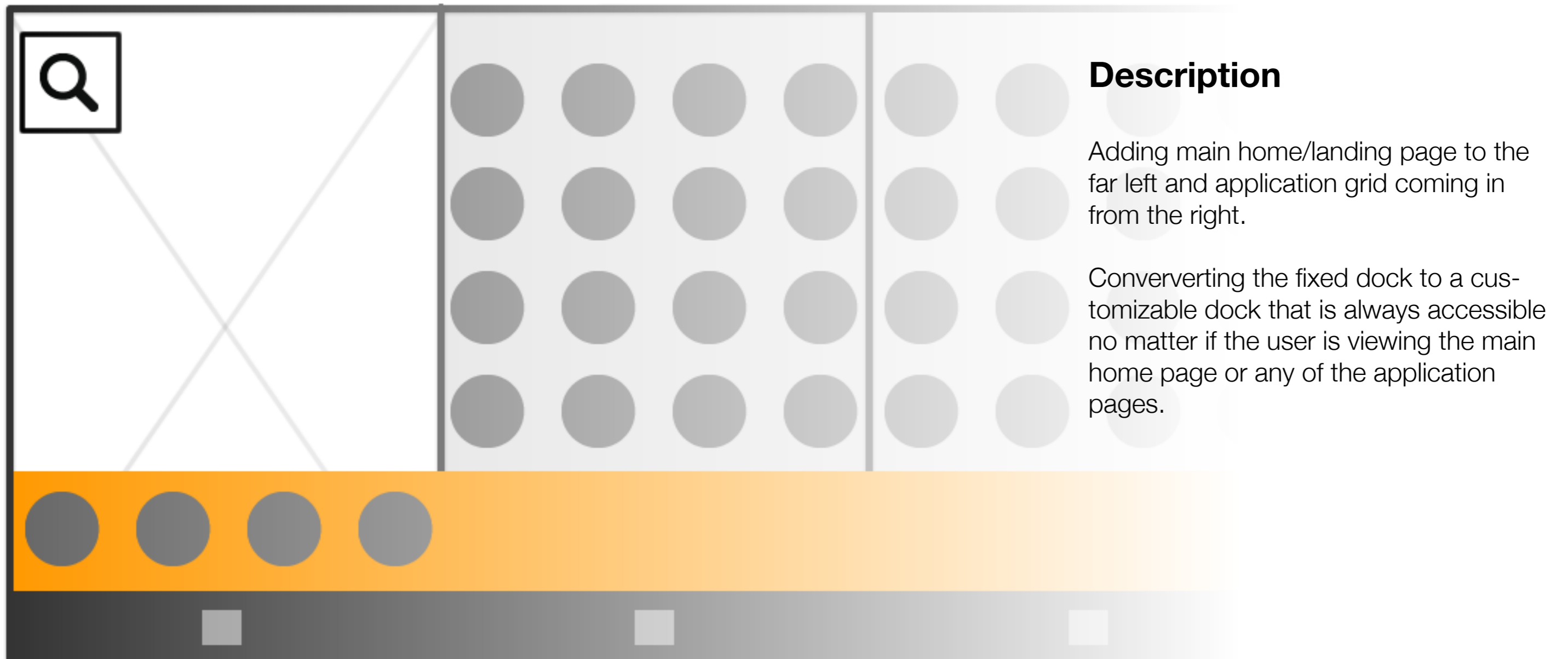

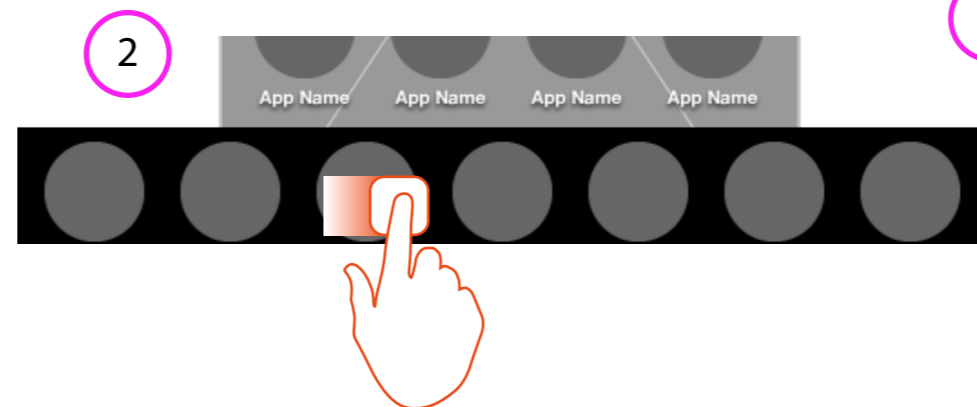
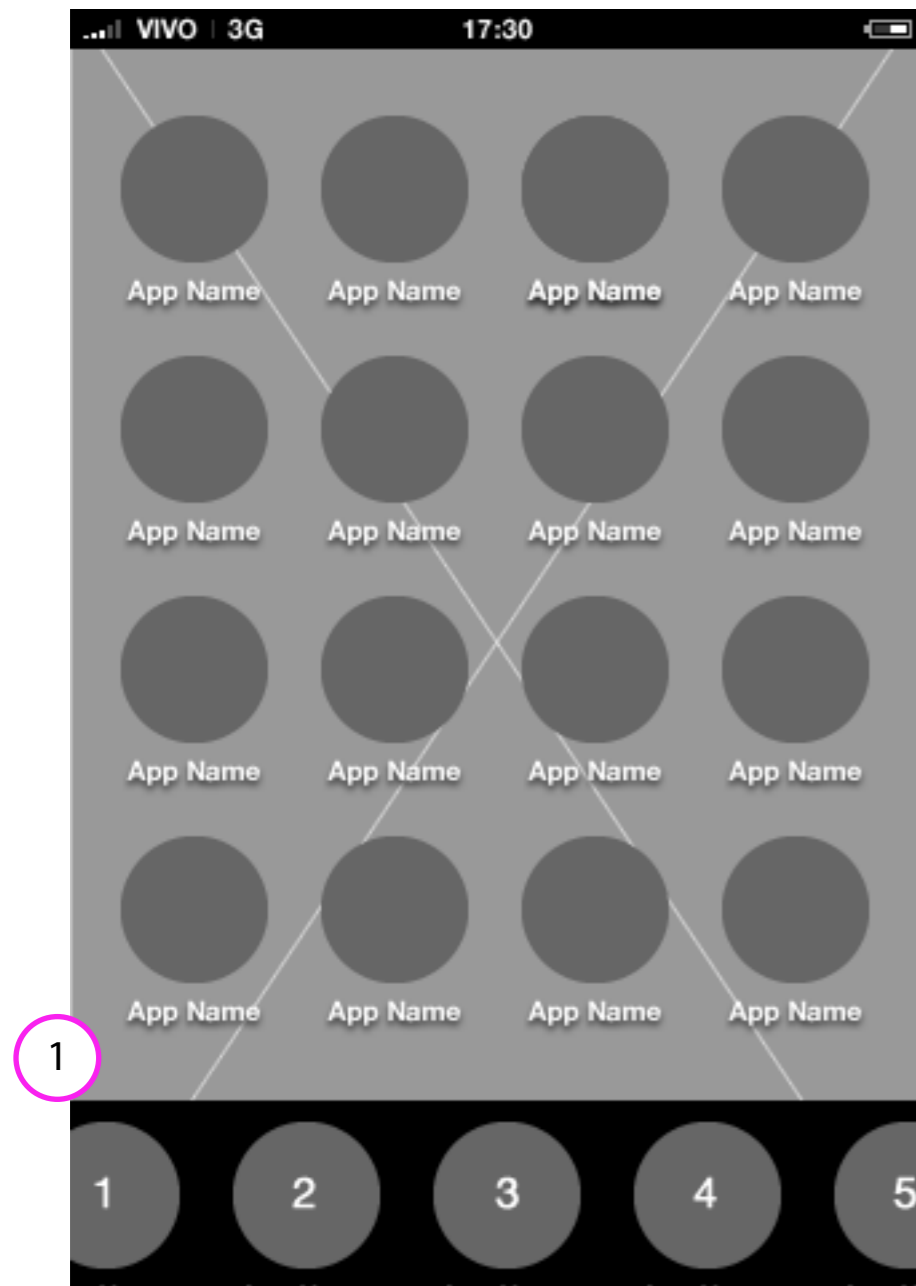

## Customizable dock behavior



### Description

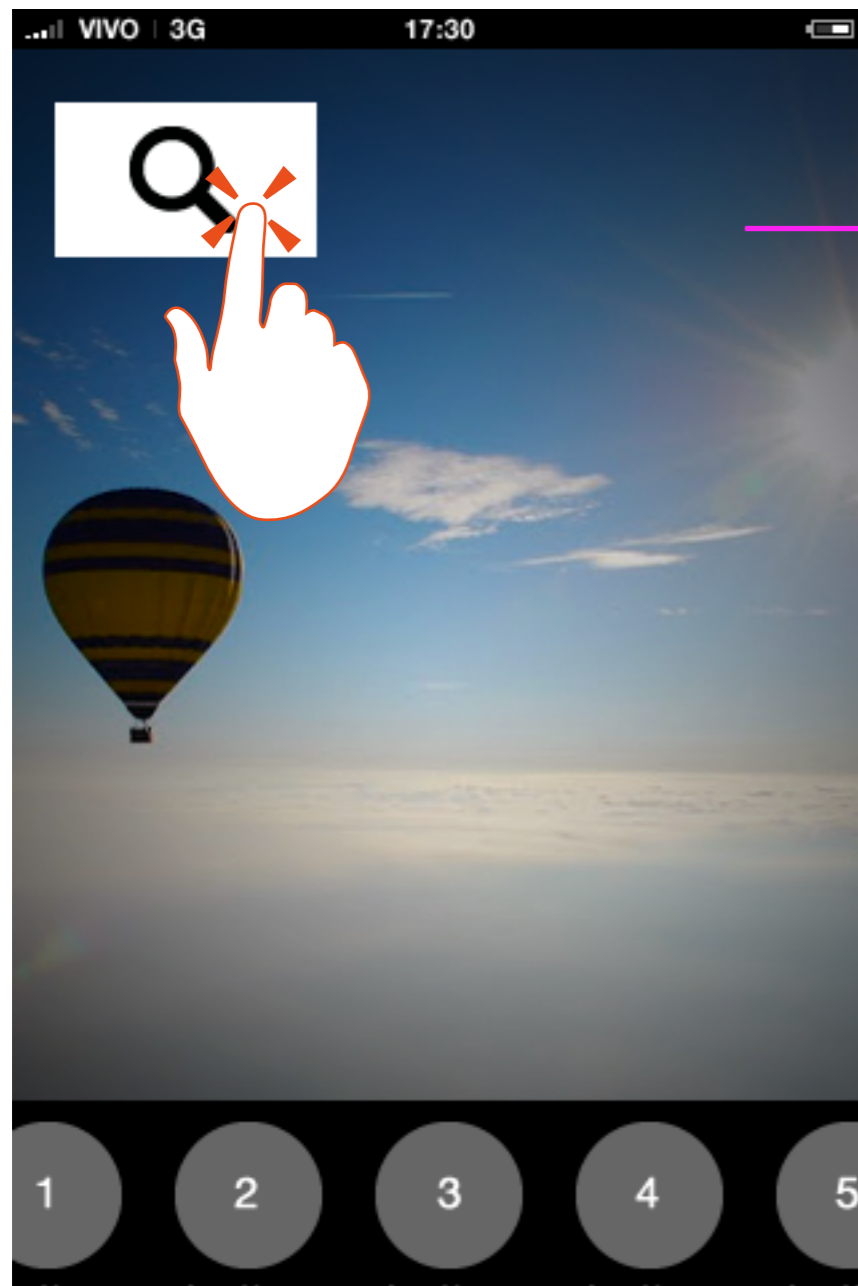
For V1, the fixed communication bar is removed



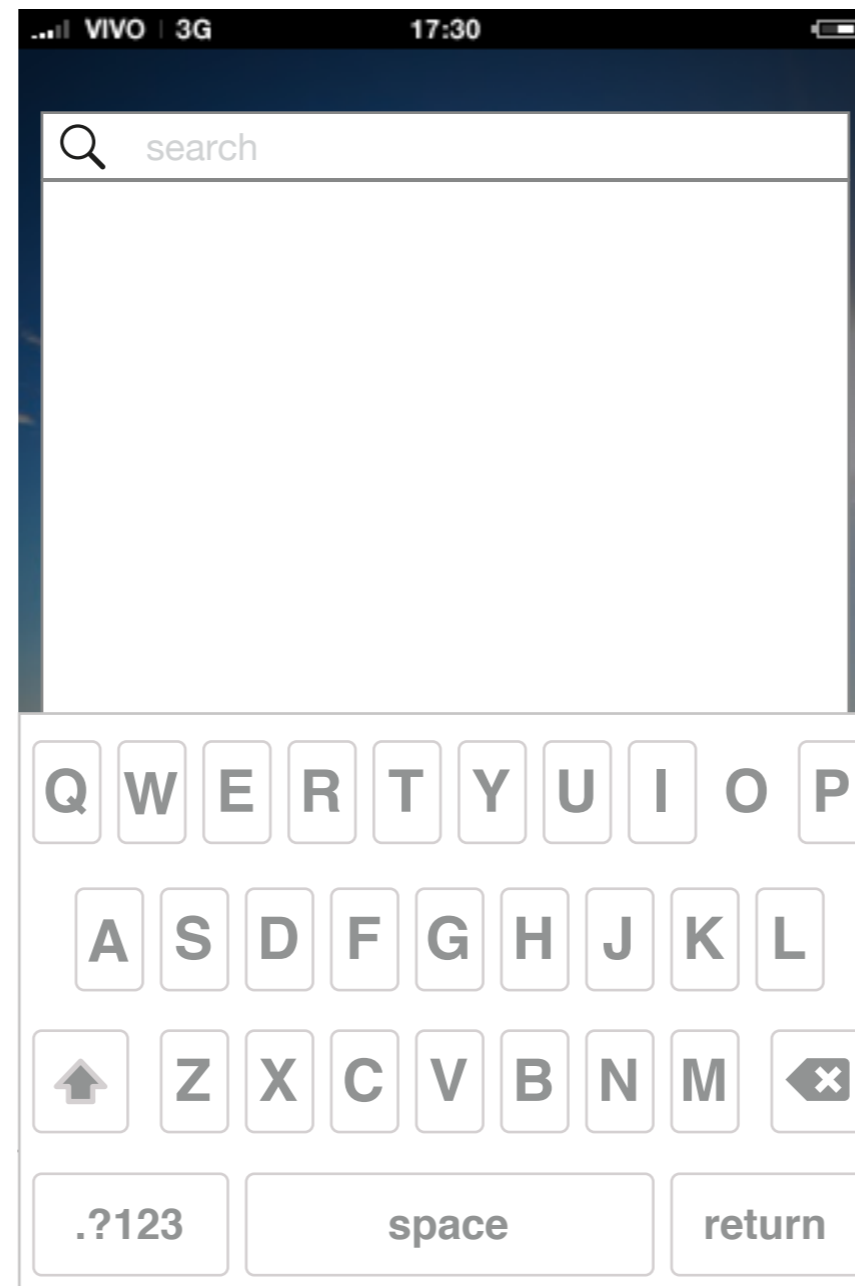
- 1 Apps can be moved between the grid and the dock. App icons in the customizable dock will be of the same size as apps in the application grid.
- 2 The dock could hold up nine apps. We propose including a horizontally gesture on the dock to scroll horizontally.

## Search from Home. (e.g. widget in home page)

### Description

In the main home screen a search widget is present together with the customizable dock.

Exact search behavior is TBD. Proposal is to initiate web search.

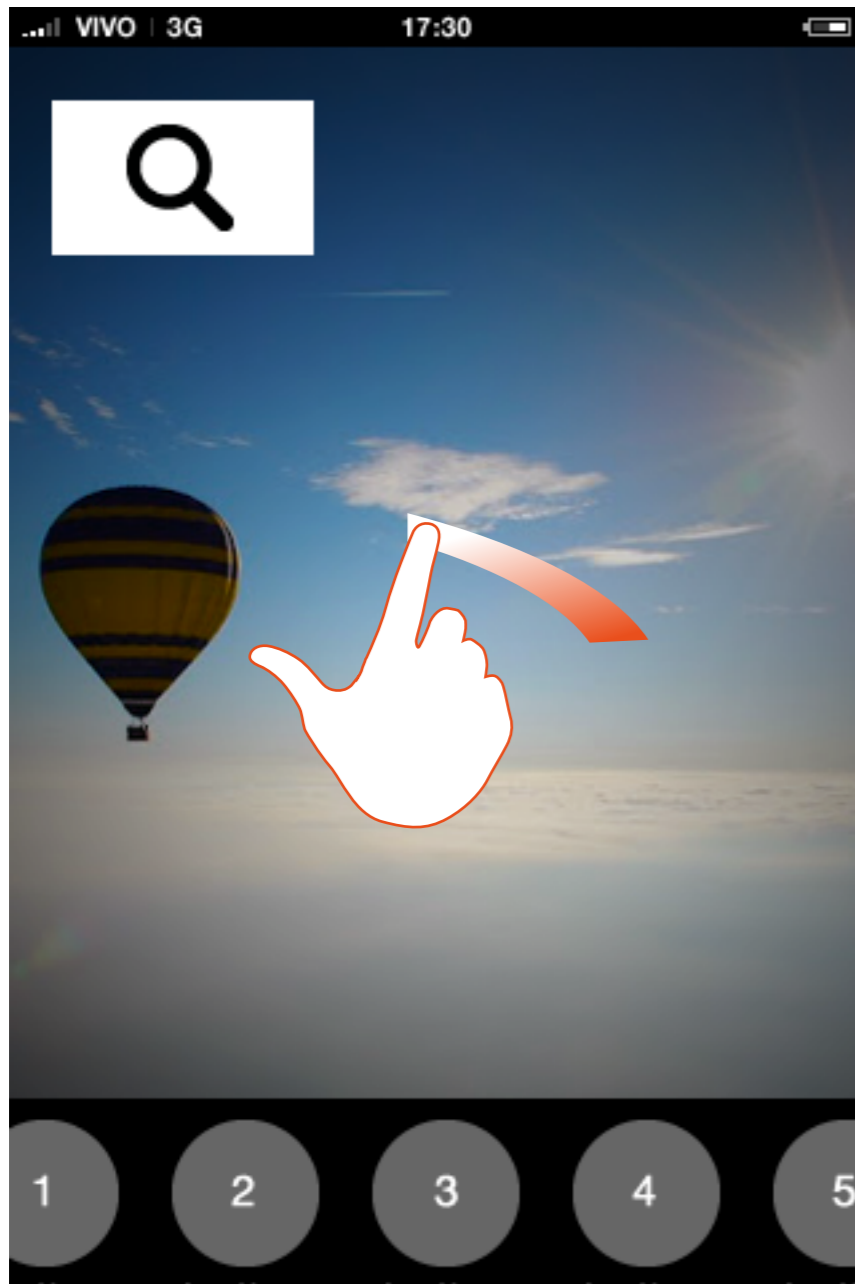

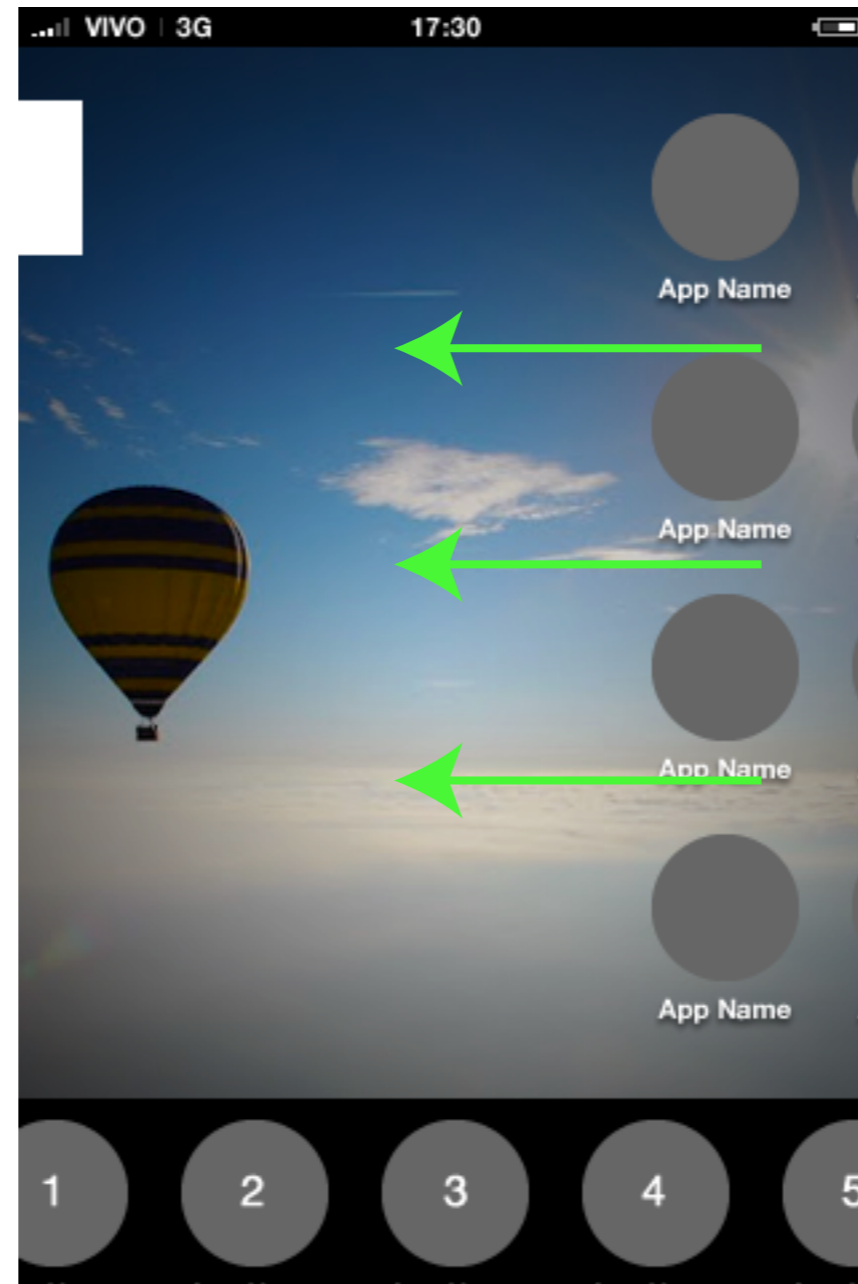
# Home screen Navigation



## Homescreen

Flick (or drag) on homescreen to bring in application grid.

NOTE: For scrolling dock, second scroll area will be in the dock zone.

Applications come in from the right side, whilst the background stays

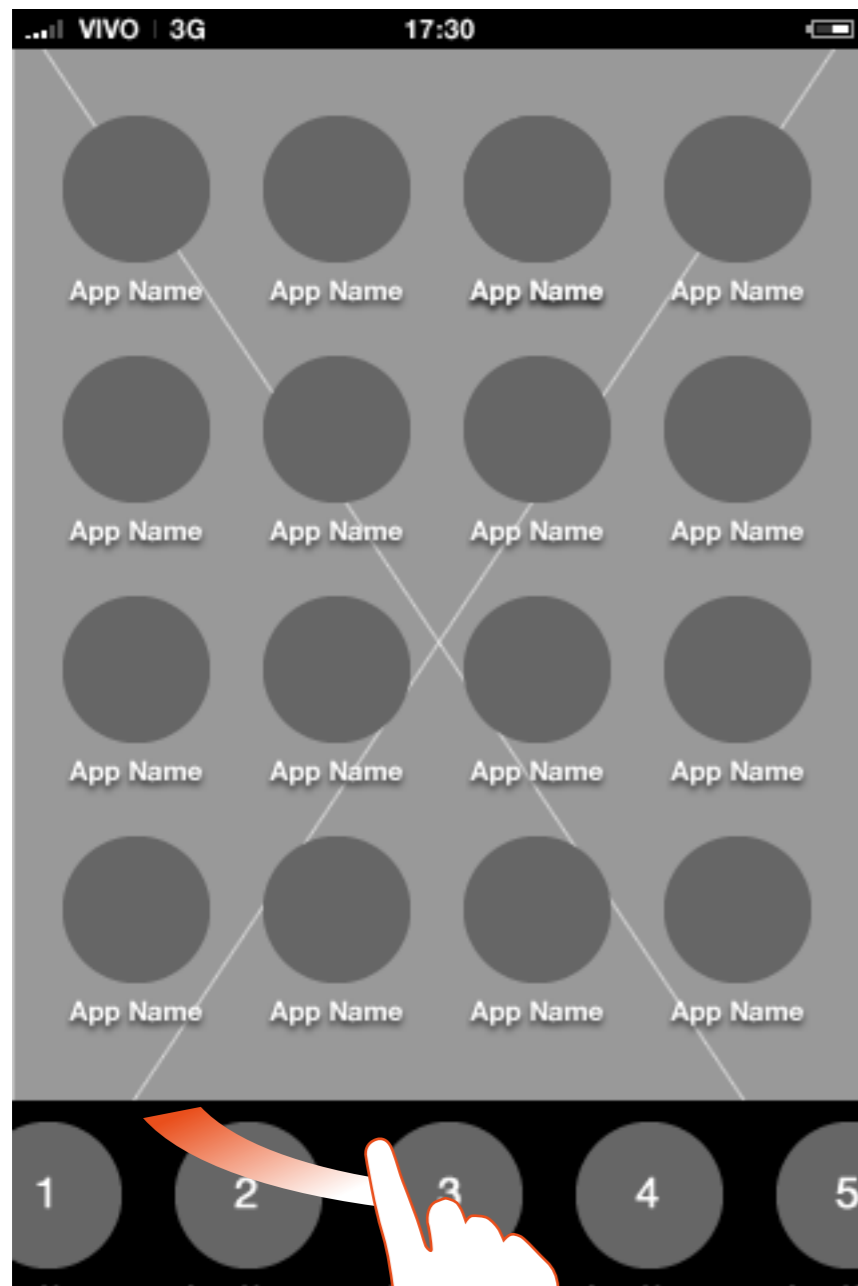


## Application grid

First page of application grid in focus.

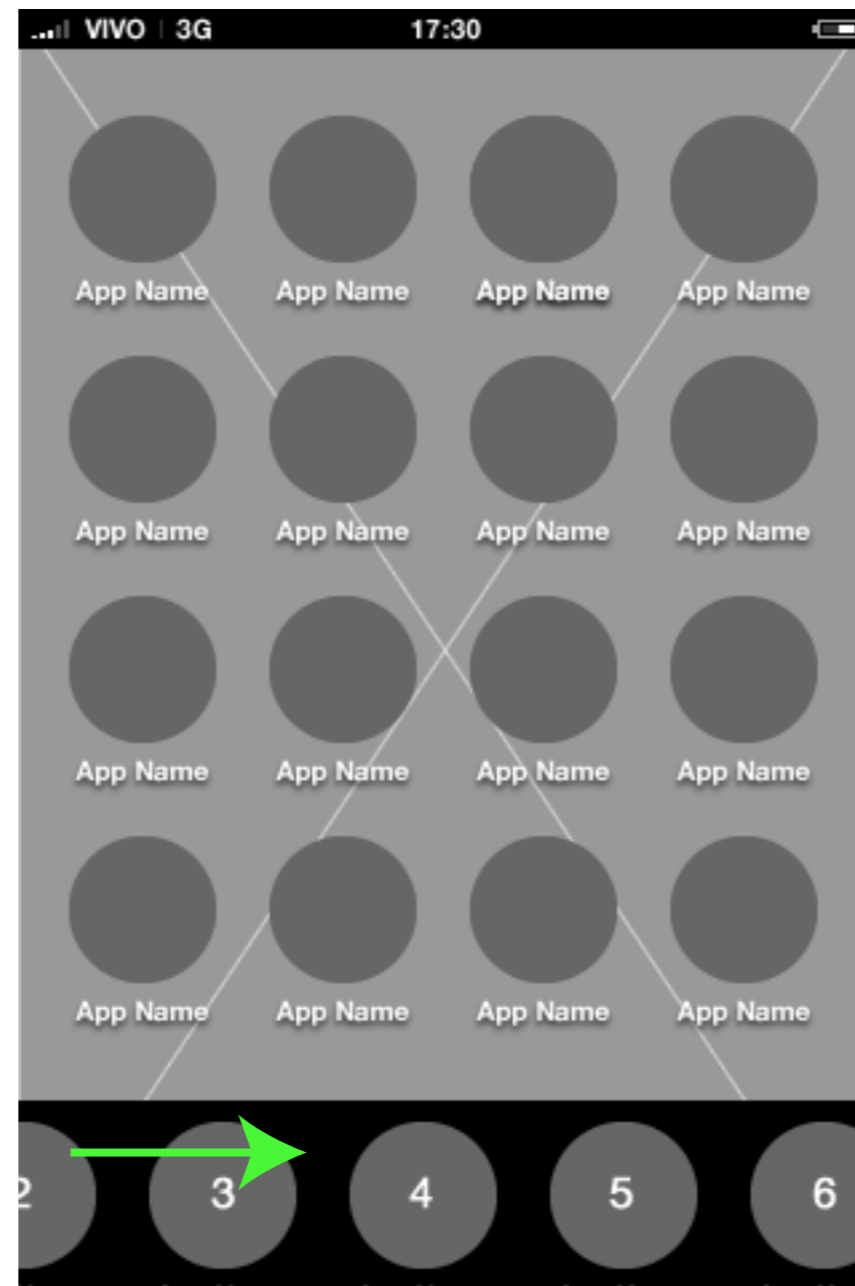

## Dock navigation



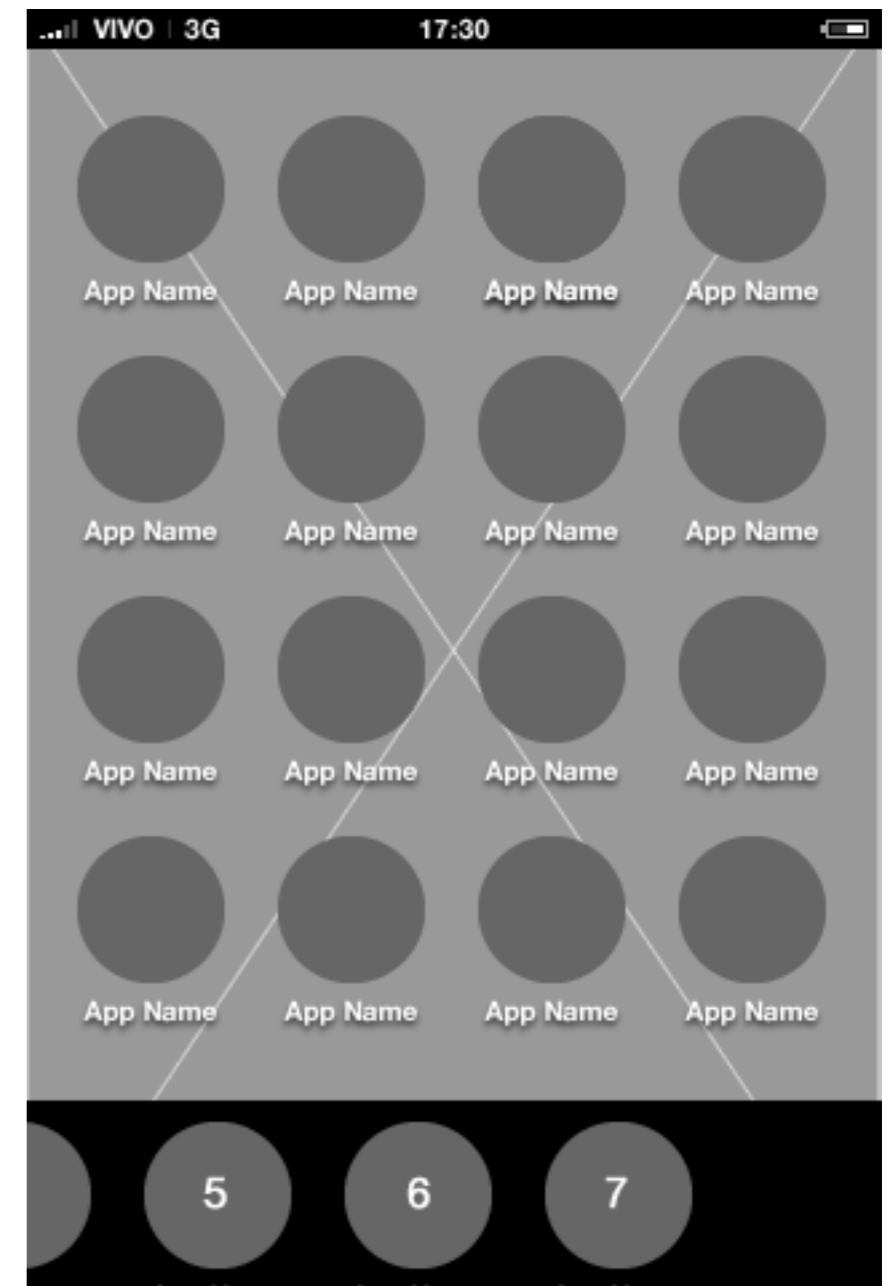
### Dock navigation

The dock animates to the second set...

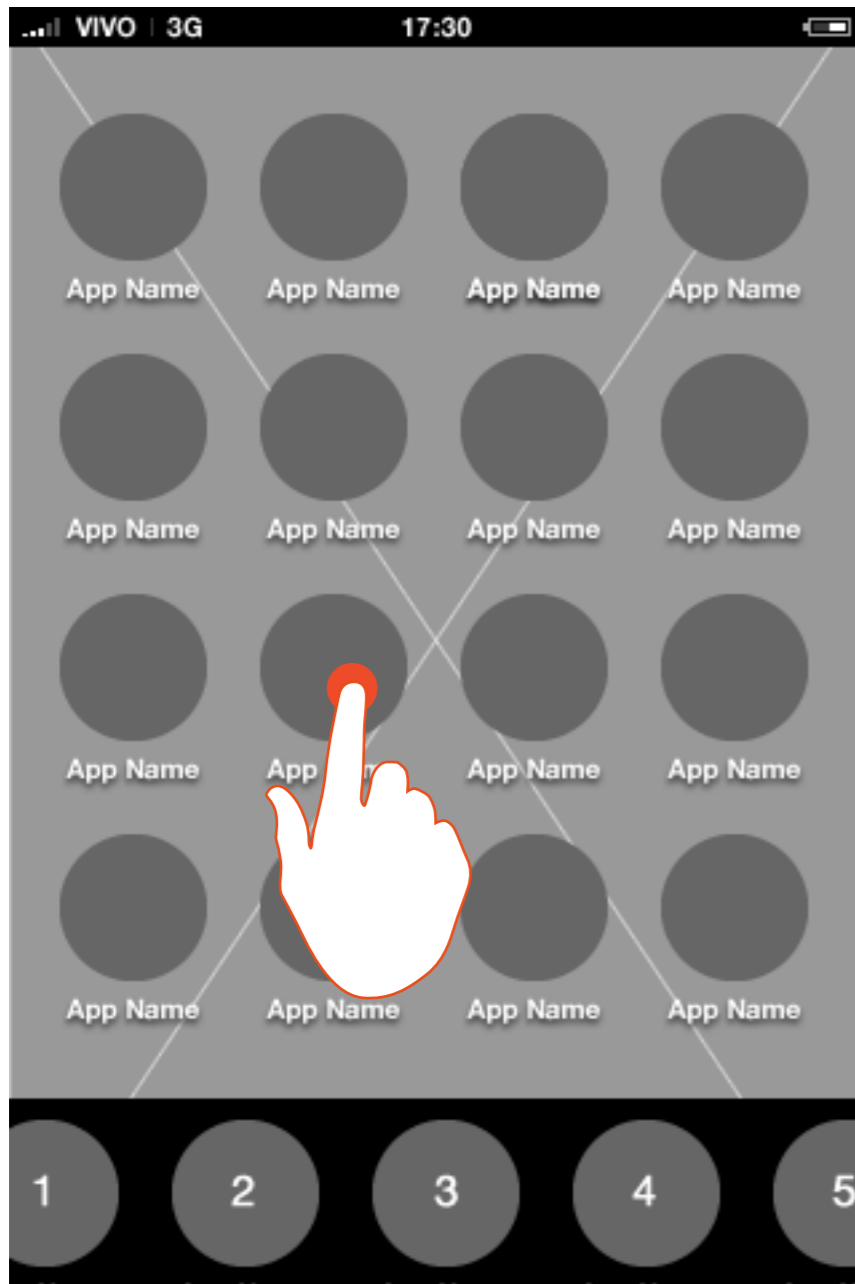


### Dock navigation

.. in which it includes one app from from the first set.

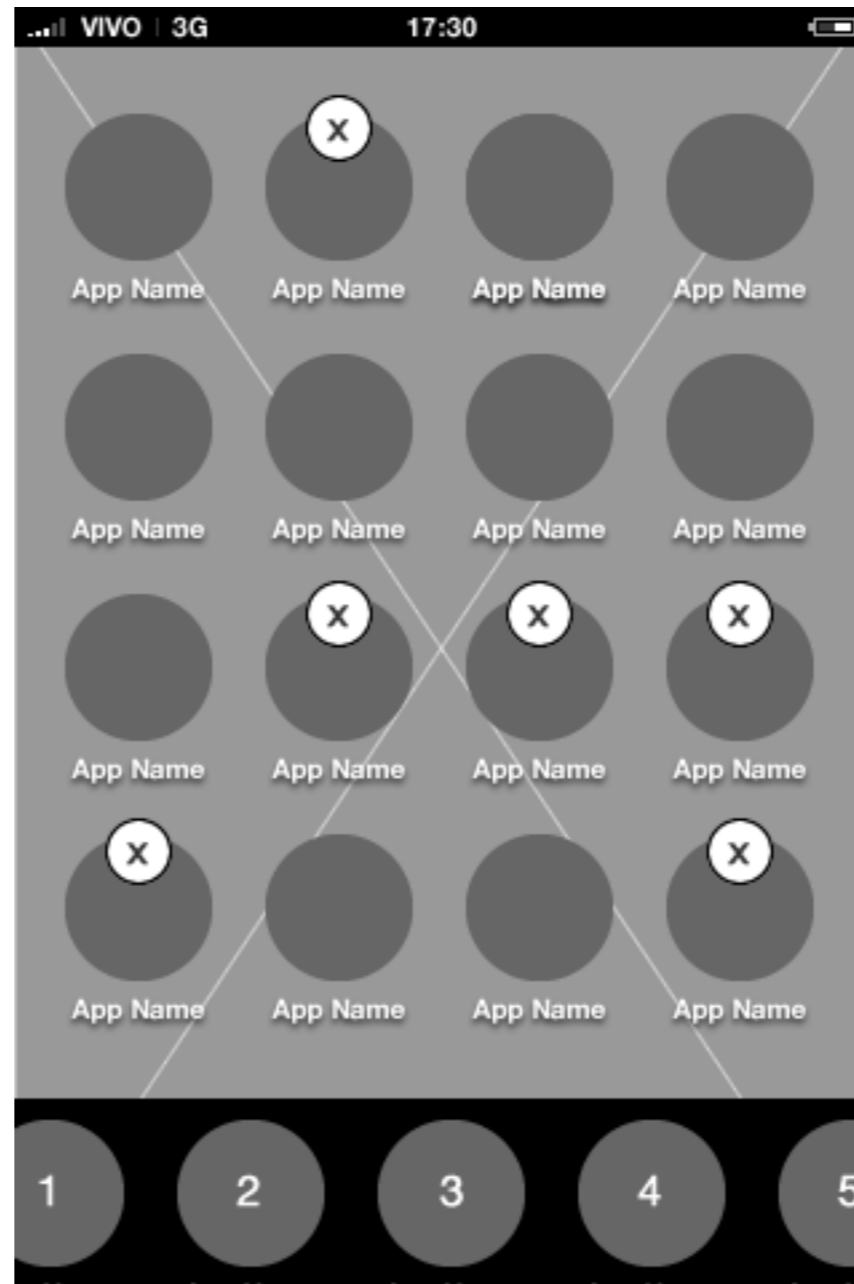

## Edit mode: **as previously agreed**



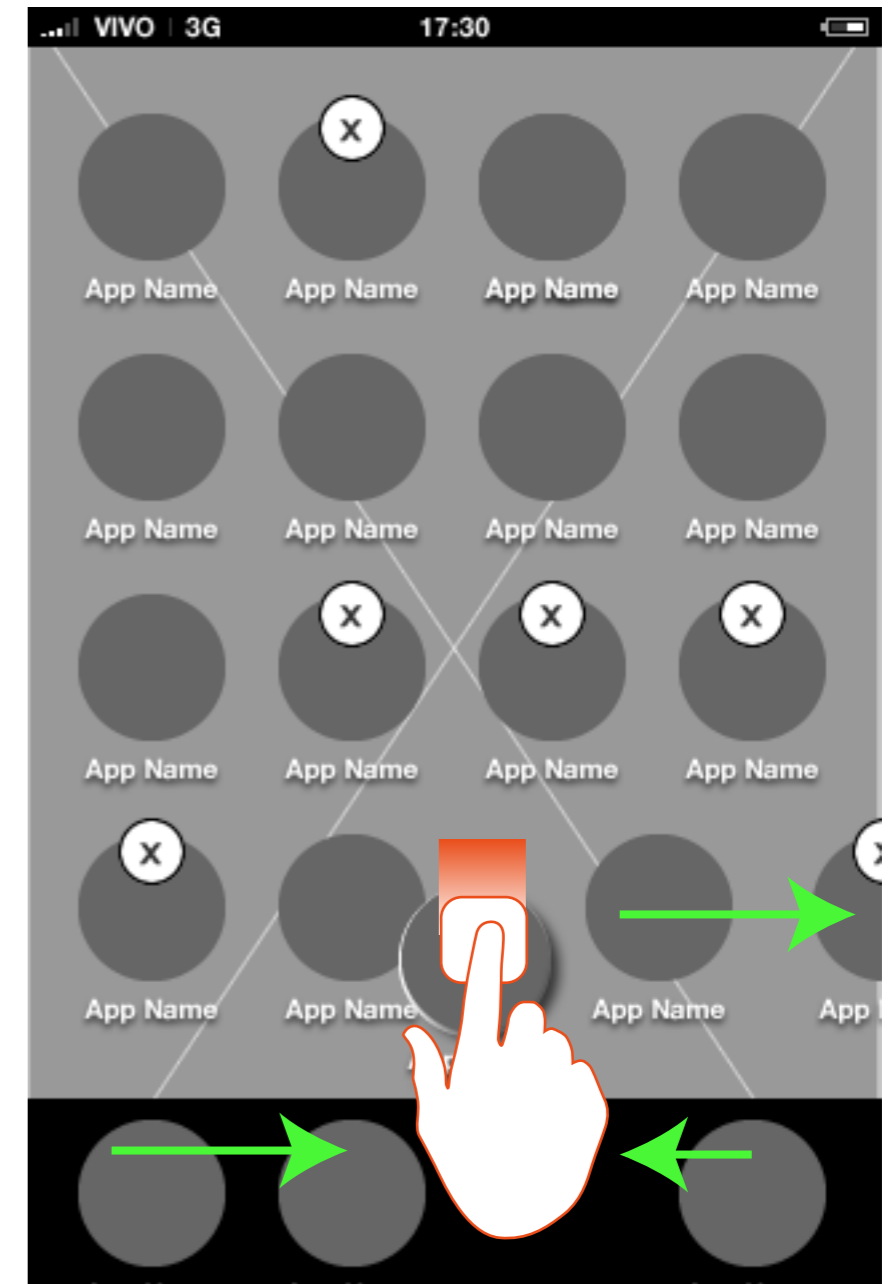
### Application grid

Long press starts edit mode.



### Application grid: edit mode

In edit mode, application deletable apps get a badge icon on top. All app icons are pulsating to indicate edit mode.



### Application grid: edit mode

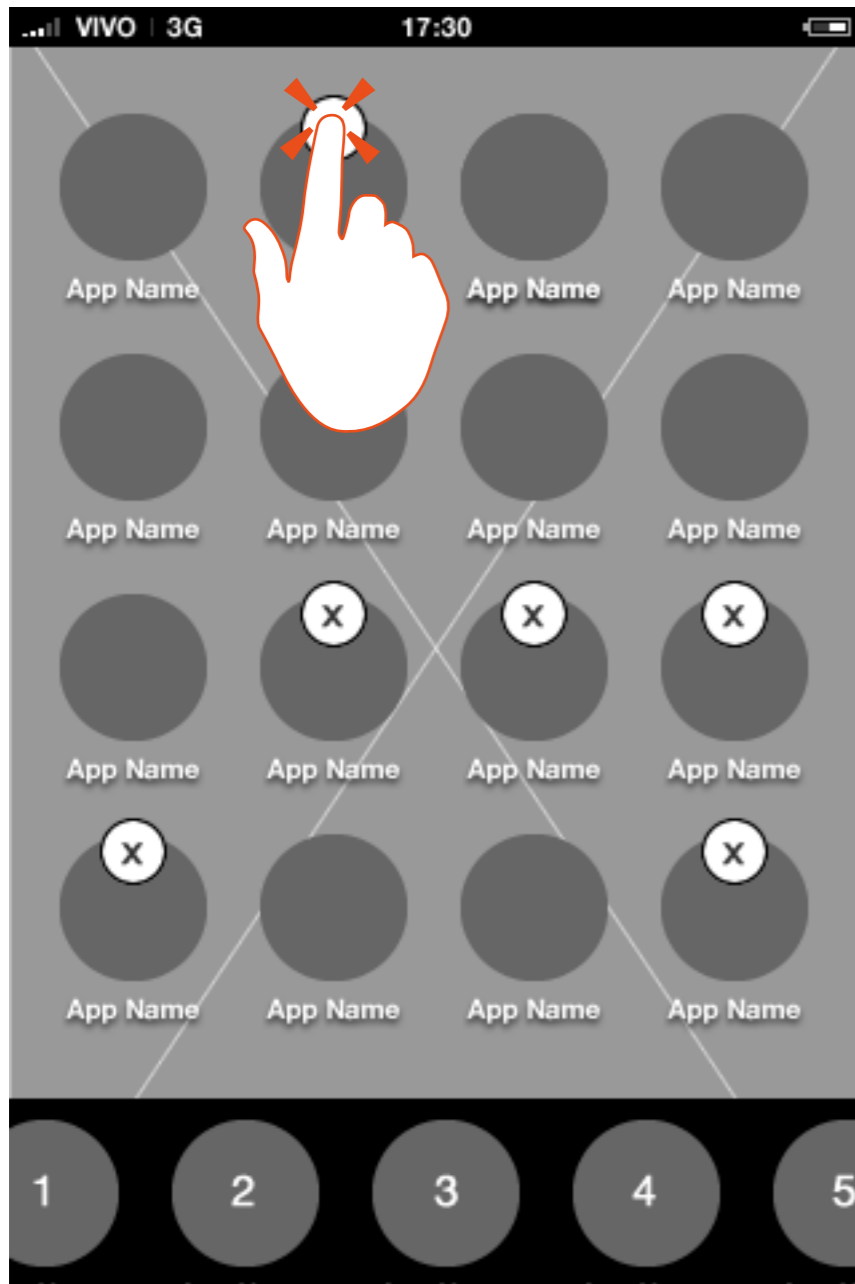
The user can drag icons in and out of the customizable dock, delete deletable apps and re-arrange application order.

Note: Applications in dock are not shortcuts.

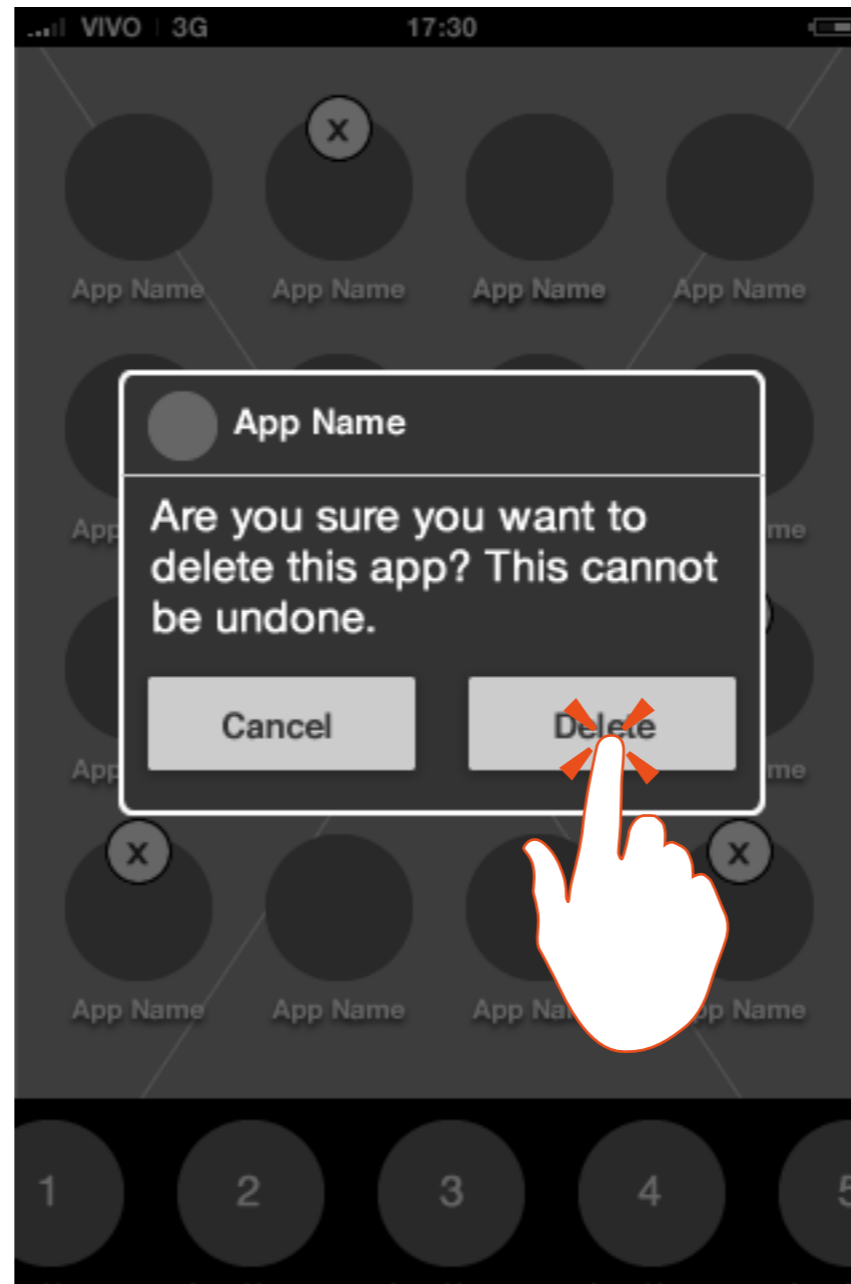

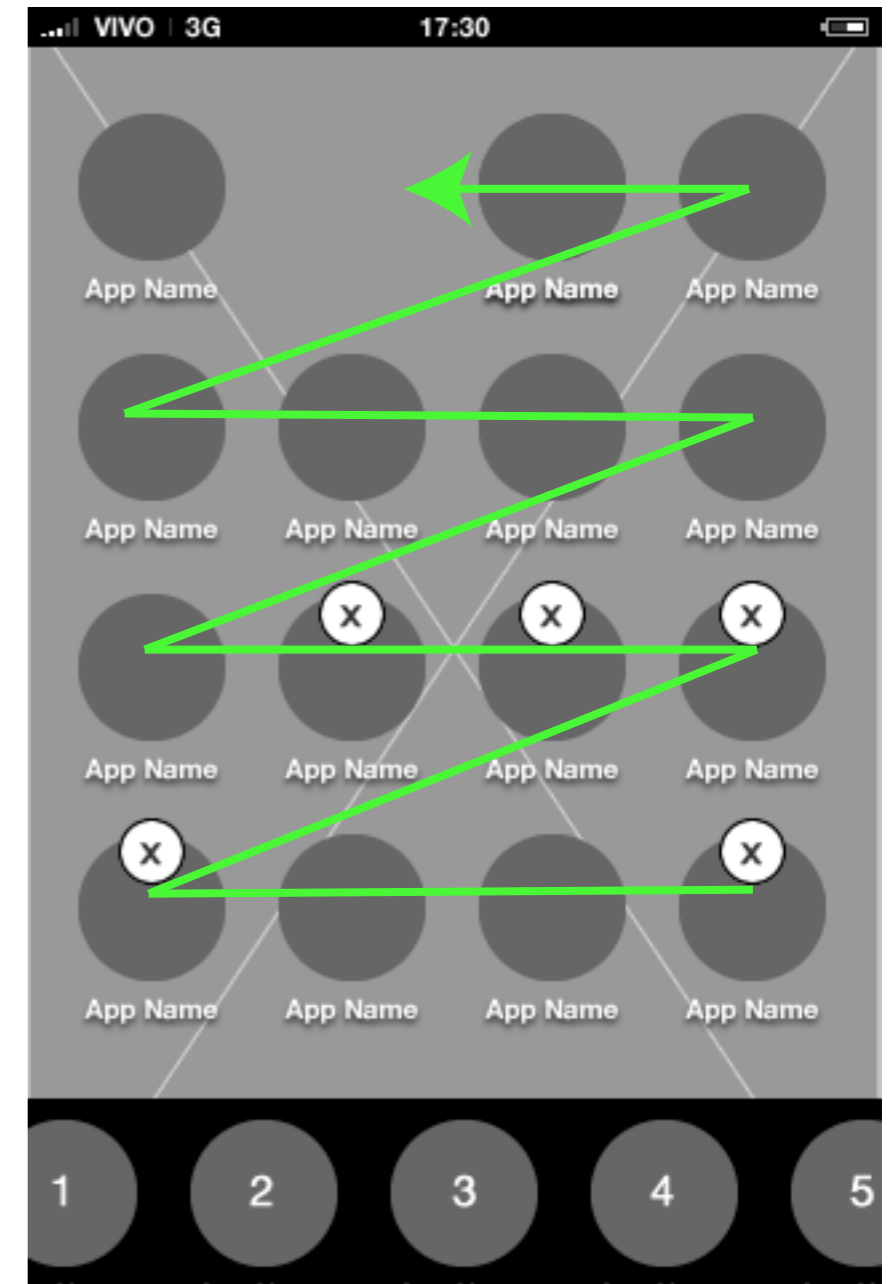
## Delete an app: **as previously agreed**

Confirm deleting the app

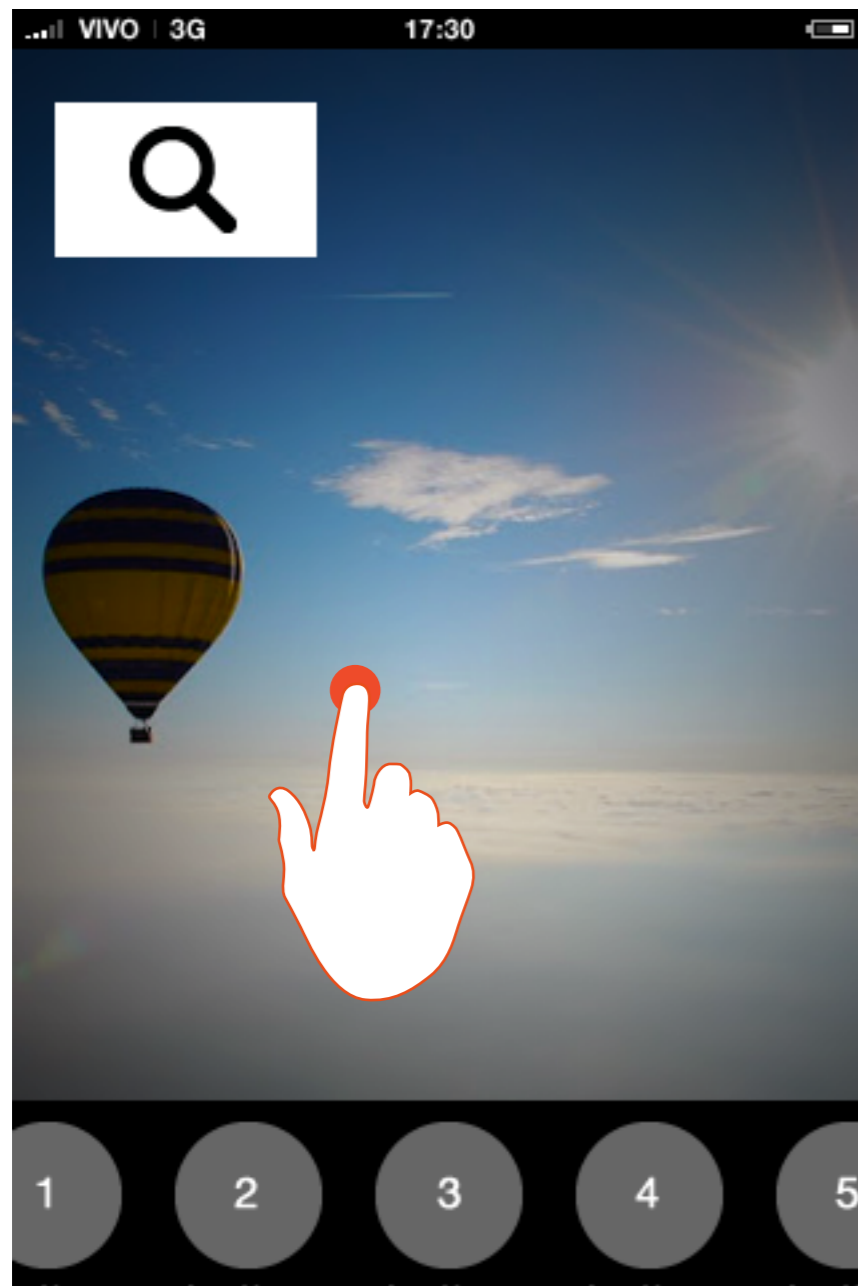


**Application grid: edit mode**

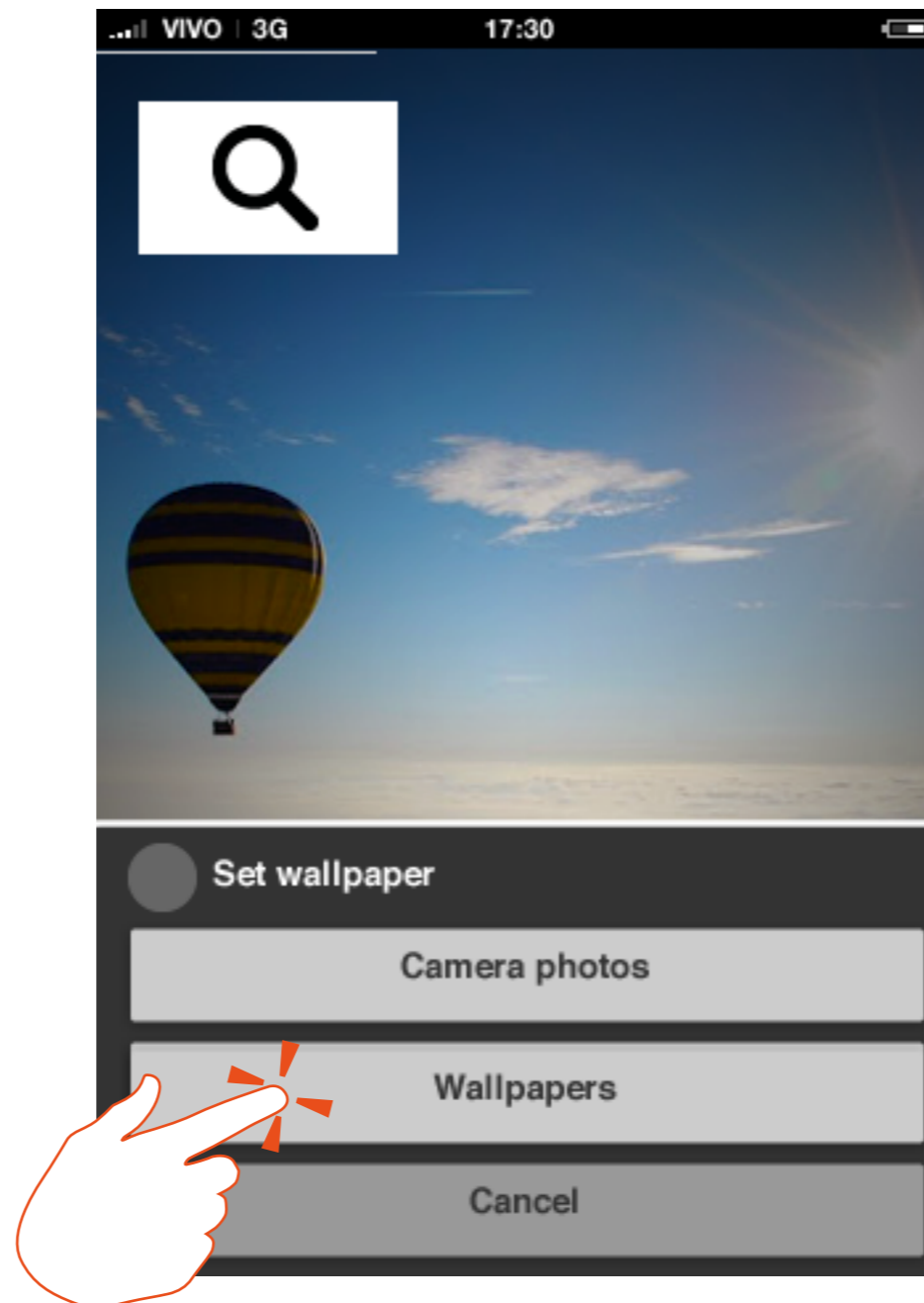
## Set wallpaper: **as previously agreed**

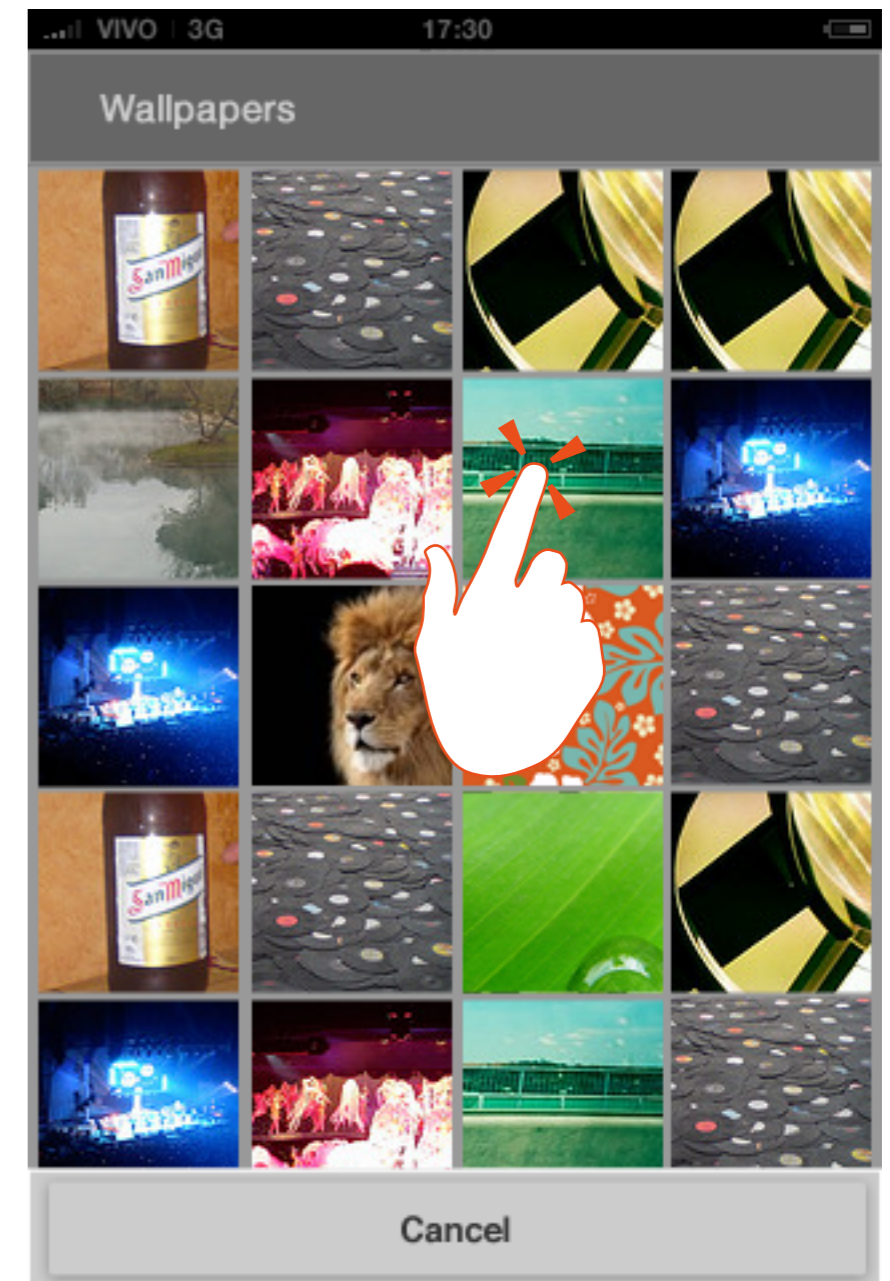
### Home screen

Long press starts on wallpaper brings up the action list from the bottom.



### Homescreen: wallpaper action list

From the action list, the user can pick wallpaper from the camera photos or from default wallpapers (which both has the same interaction flow)

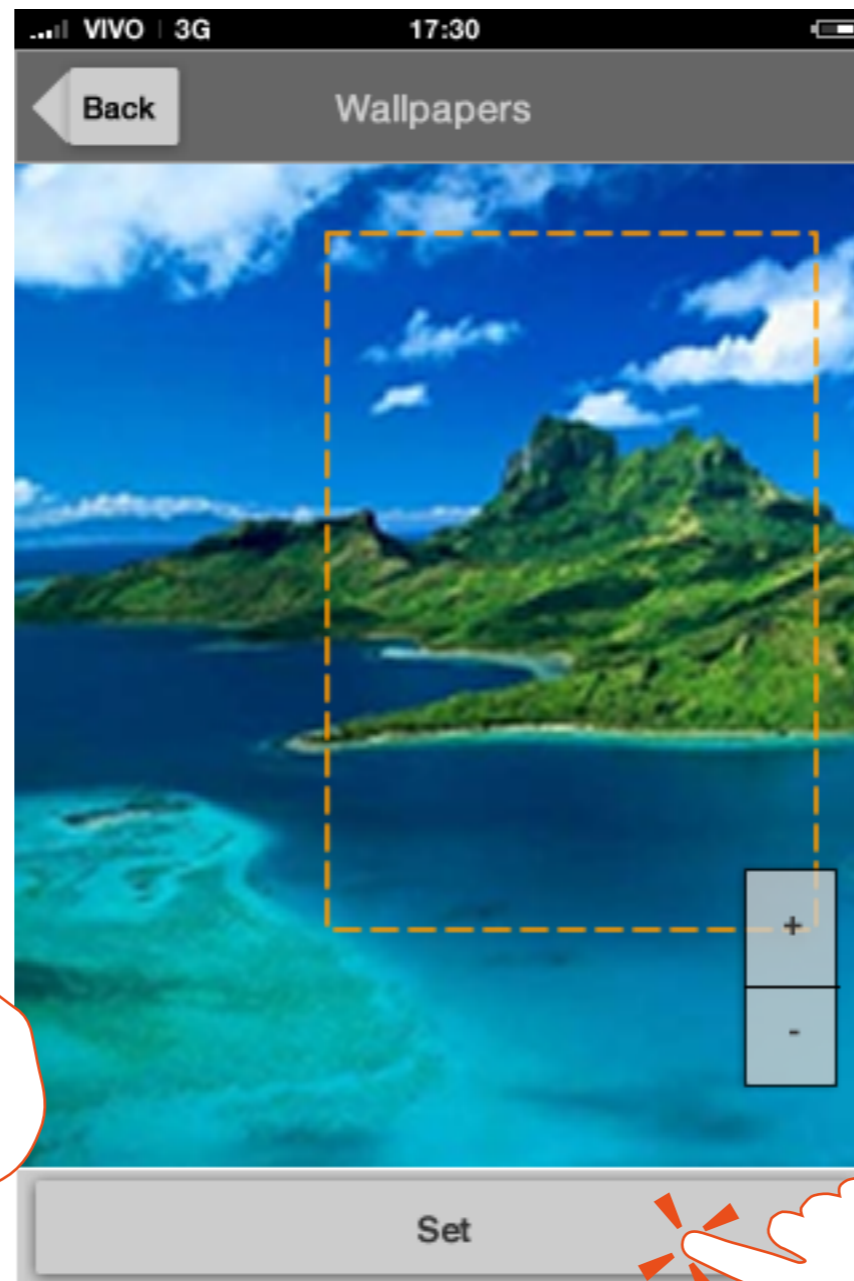
## Set wallpaper

### Set wallpaper

The Zoom in/out keys allows the user to pick a specific area of a photo.



### Set wallpaper

The user can move around the frame to pick what part to be the wallpaper.

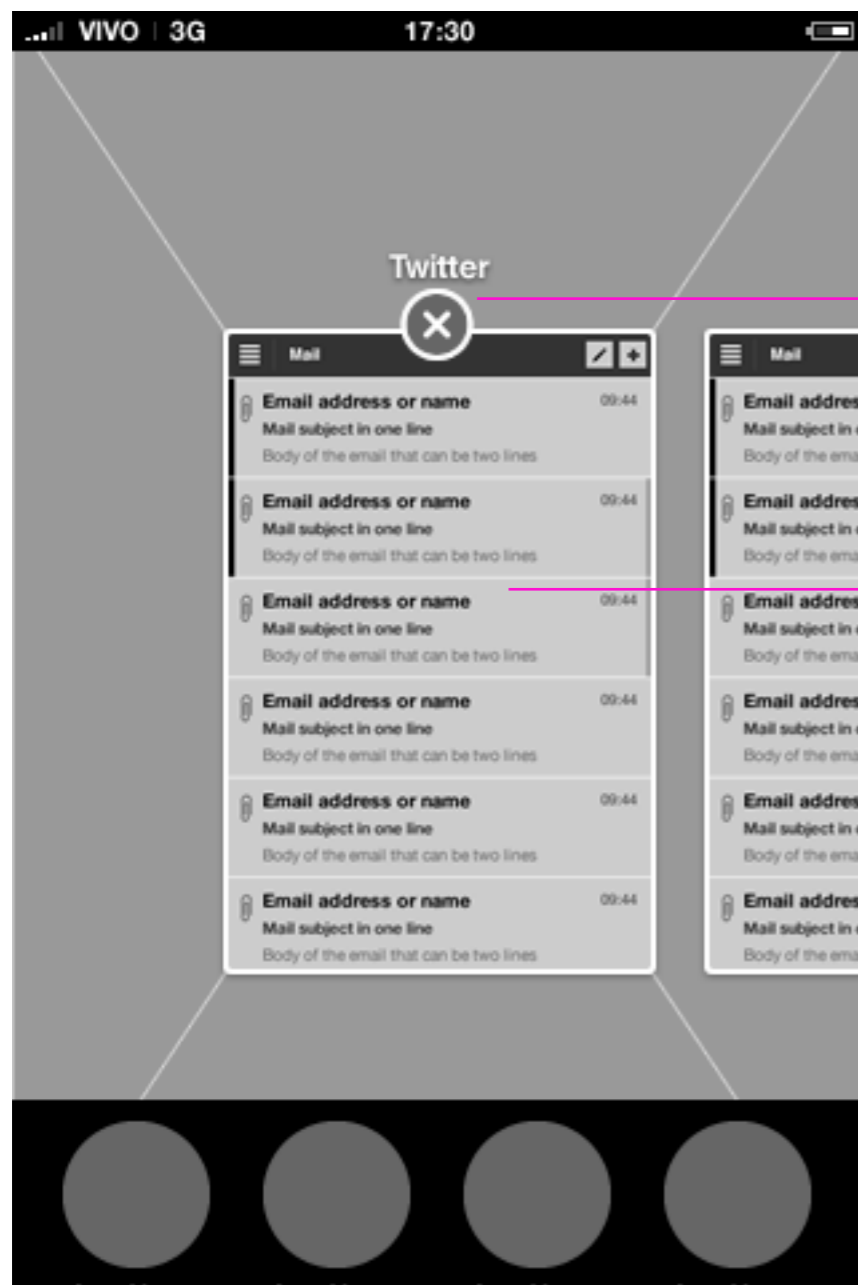


### Homescreen

New wallpaper appears as soon as user has pressed the set button.

# Home screen

## Task switcher



1 Tap to close application

2 Swipe horizontally to move to next/previous app  
Tap to open app

## Description

Task switching is accessed through long press on the hardware home key. By default the last active application is shown to the very left, followed by up to 19 other applications (20 in total in order to keep a smooth performance). The task switcher holds all active applications and lets the user scroll horizontally between them. By tapping an active application the user access it and it's last state.

Whenever accessing the task switcher, the dock will always be found in the bottom giving quick access to the users favorite apps.

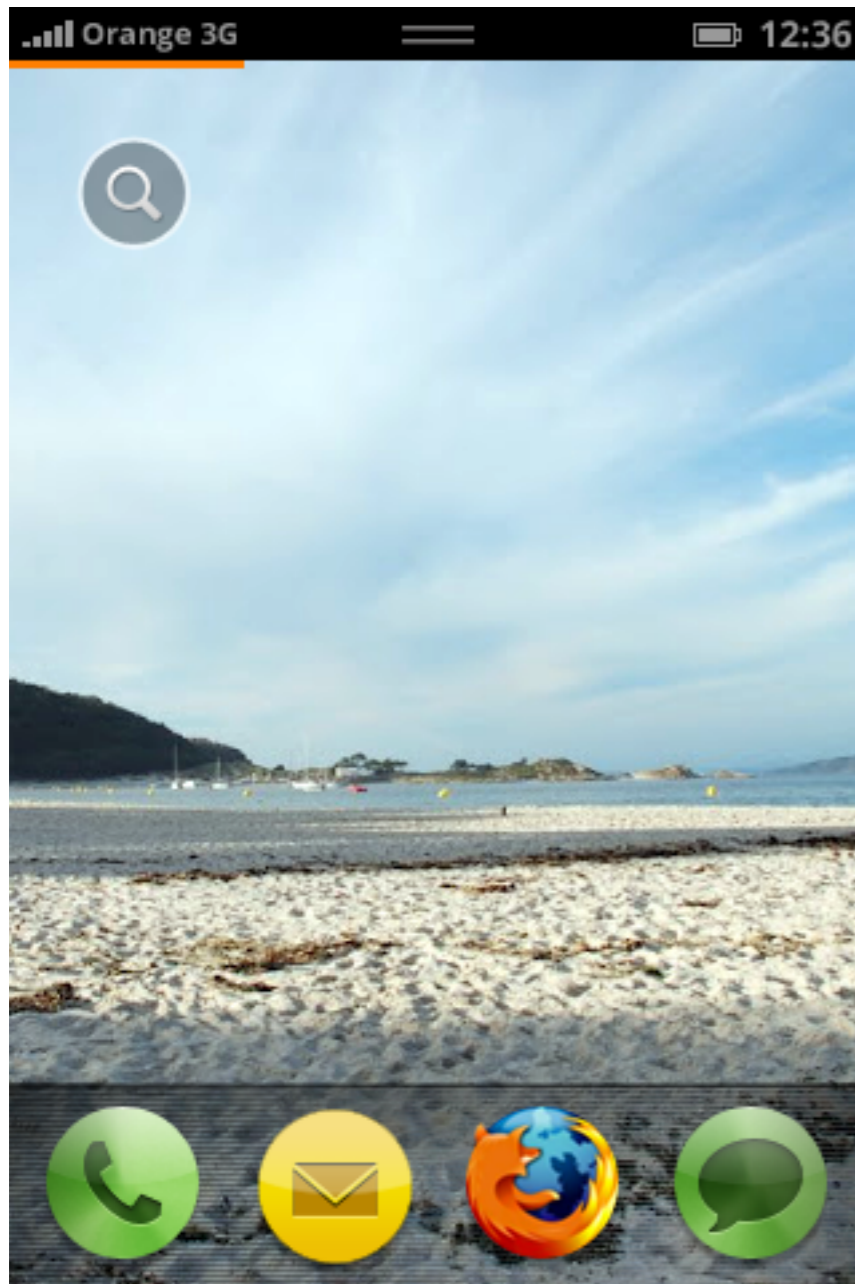
Note: Current implementation does not have the dock. Previous designs incorporated the search bar which is now on homescreen/landing page.

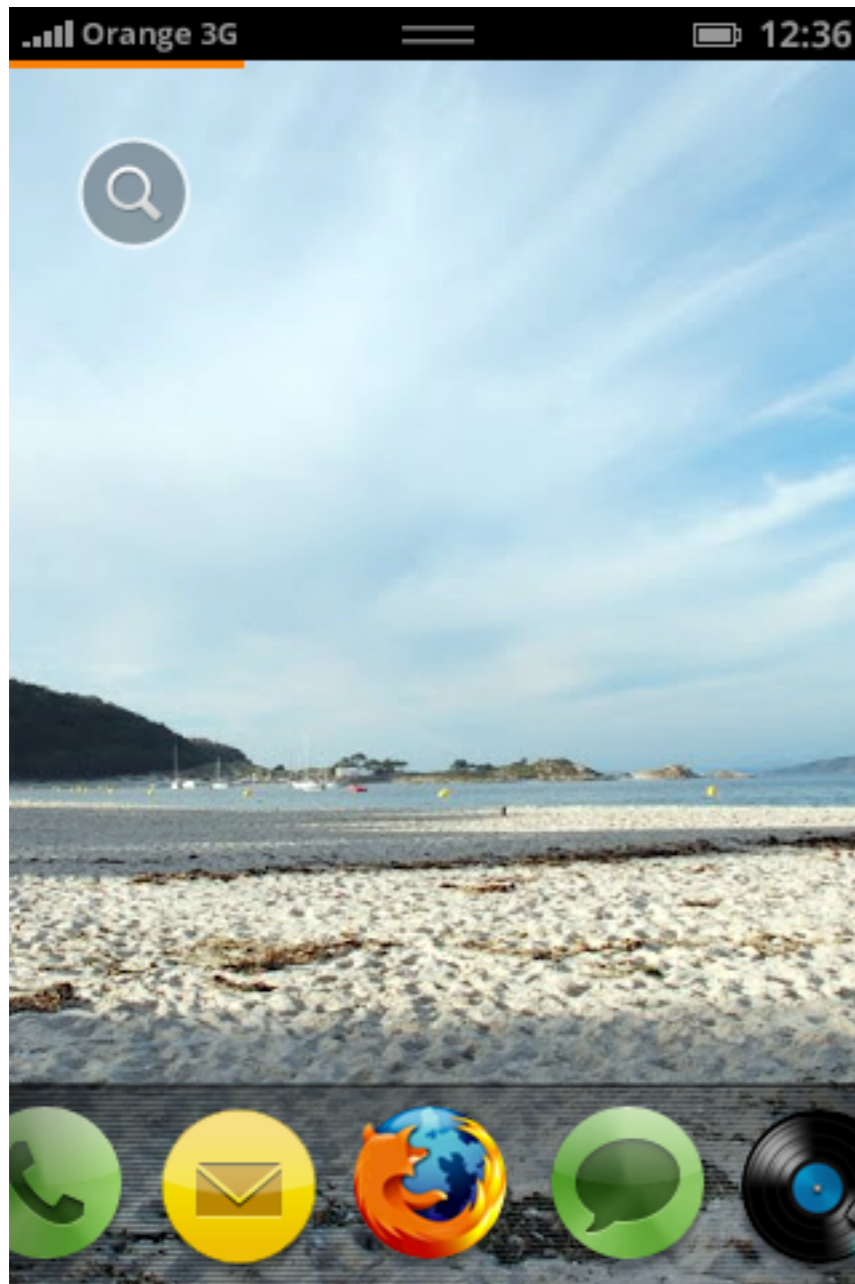
